She was a private piano instructor, accompanist, and church organist. She was an active member in the Musical Art Club, Kansas City Musical Club, and Women's Committee of the Conservatory.

Dixie Lou was a member of Sigma Alpha lota International Music Fraternity (SAI) for just short of 80 years, having joined in 1942. Throughout her membership, she served in capacities of local, regional, and national leadership, winning every award SAI offers.
